The **early bird conference fee is 350,00 € (£295,00)**, which covers the programme. It does not include accommodation or travel to the conference, which you need to arrange for yourself.

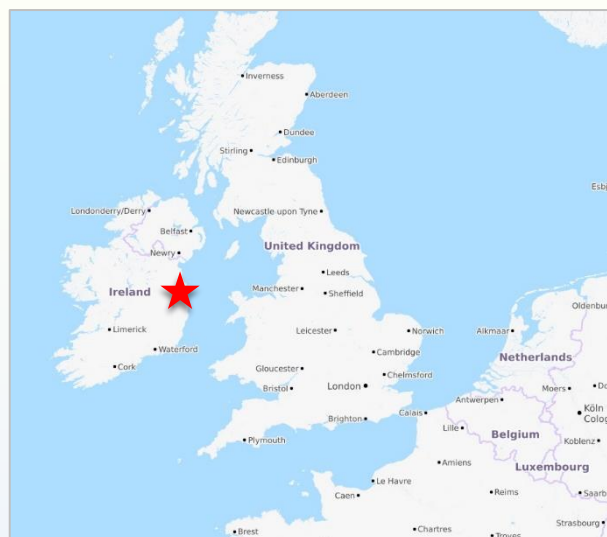

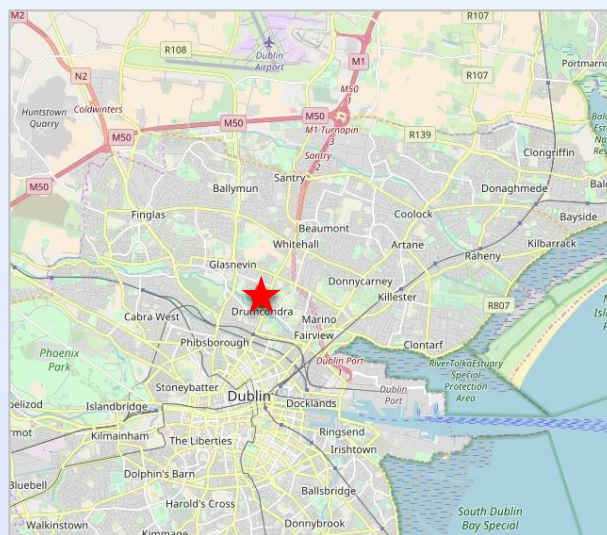
